

2019-2020 School Year Tuition and Fee Schedule

Effective 8/26/2019

Included in (but not limited to) your daily tuition is programming that provides early childhood education utilizing Highscope® Curriculum, a safe and secure setting, healthy food program with breakfast, lunch and snack prepared daily with primarily local farm to school organic and non-GMO fruits, vegetables, whole grains, lean proteins and milk. (Infants receive either breast milk or organic and non-GMO formula, iron-fortified cereal and baby food), enrichment, and a birthday treat.

First Light Early Education Center is closed each year on the seven (7) main holidays: Please see the school calendar posted on our website and in the center for specific closure dates.

The School-Age program follows the School District #2 Calendar and care is **only** provided to those as needed at an additional cost to include in-service days, parent teacher conferences and breaks. Notification is required by the 15th of the previous month or at the beginning of each semester. First Light Early Education Center also offers a Summer Enrichment program for school age kids up to age 8.

PAYMENT POLICIES:

- All payments are required in advance of service.
- All tuition and program fees are non-refundable.
- Children enrolling in a program mid-month or mid-semester will have pro-rated tuition at the daily rate listed above with fees as applicable.
- Monthly installments will be assessed an additional \$20.00 bookkeeping fee per payment and will be due on the 20th of each month. No Bookkeeping fee is charged if paying by semester.
- Paying by semester includes the ability to credit planned absences to the next semester's billing. First Light must be notified in advance, in writing.
- Acceptable forms of payment include automatic withdrawal from a checking or savings account and credit cards. First Light does not accept cash or checks.
- Families who pay by semester save money in two ways:
 - Families are not charged a bookkeeping fee.
 - Planned absences from your regular schedule that come up outside of the billing cycle are credited to a families next semester billing. So for example, say you pay for your regular schedule, then you end up finding out you have a life event and have to leave for a funeral, a wedding, a surgery or grandparents decide they want to take your child(ren) for a week, families would let us know ASAP, then those unused days would be credited to the next semester billing. This doesn't include sick days or unplanned absences.

OTHER FEES AND DEPOSITS:

- Registration: A non-refundable \$75 fee due with Enrollment Application or after any disruption in service provided.
